Welcome to another newsletter for Term 1. It's again been a busy time with lots happening here at Banyule Primary over the past fortnight. This week we welcomed our Preps to a full-time program, having not attending Wednesdays for February. They continue to impress us with their transition into Primary School world, however a funny interaction this week when a child exclaimed "Hi Mrs Flemahan!!" shows we've still got a little work to do!!

School Review

Our school review has also officially begun since our last newsletter. We have now completed the observational phase of the process, having had the review panel visit our school across several days. This has involved observing lessons in all year levels, interviews with teaching teams and discussions with student and parent focus groups.

While we now await our report, we are extremely pleased to share that initial feedback from the panel has been overwhelmingly positive, praising everything they have seen and heard during their time with us. It is incredibly validating to know that our combined efforts and hard work have been recognised by the panel and reassuring to know that the strategic decisions in our approach to teaching and learning are having the impact and outcomes we intended.

Playground and School Yard Works

While our major playground project continues slowly in the hands of Departmental decision-makers and construction compliance-checkers, we creep closer to the time our basketball court makeover gets underway, with work beginning later in the term. This project is being undertaken by us as a school (as opposed to the Department-managed major building

project) with some funding-help from the North-East Link. The majority of this work will be done during the Easter break and we can't wait to unveil yet another new amazing space to our school community in Term 2.

We are also pleased to announce another project that we are undertaking in our yard. Again, separate to the building project, we have just given the go-ahead for landscapers to begin work rejuvenating the embankment between our BER building and Banyule Road. The work will involve retaining walls, climbing rocks, garden beds and pathways. Having previously been unsuccessful in a grant application for this area we have now prioritised this worn out area as a school-funded project. Our Community Engagement Committee would like to support this project by fundraising for soft landscaping such as plants and garden mulch, for which we are grateful.

You can see this area in its current form below, as well as concept drawings provided to our landscapers for reference.







We are looking forward to the time when our physical environment will finally be matching the outstanding learning environment we have created.

Prep 2026 Enrolment Timeline

The following timeline advises families of when and how to enrol their child into Prep at a Victorian government school.

To start primary school in 2026, your child will need to turn 5 years old by the 30th of April 2026.

Students residing within our school zone are guaranteed a place at our school, which is determined by your permanent residential address, followed by priority placement for siblings. We may also accept enrolments from families outside the designated zone, if there are available places.

Our school manages enrolments using the Department's Placement Policy.

What you need to do:

- 1. Use the Find my School website https://www.findmyschool.vic.gov.au/ to locate your designated neighbourhood school (local school). Your child's local school is determined on the basis of your permanent residential address.
- 2. Attend the Information evening or contact our Administration Office (03) 9459 0732 to book a
- Application forms will be available from Tuesday 22nd April 2025 via our website or can be collected from our school Administration Office.
- 4. Submit your child's application form by Friday 25th July 2025.
- 5. If you can provide proof of residency with your application, or you have a child already enrolled in the school, you are guaranteed a place at the school. You will be emailed enrolment documents.
- 6. If you're out of zone, you will be notified of the outcome of your application between Monday 28th July and Friday 8th of August 2025.
- 7. Enrolled students will take part in transition sessions during Term 4, 2025.
- 8. Your child will start Prep on Thursday 29th January 2026.

Enrolment applications submitted after the **25th of July 2025** will be processed by our school as they are received, in accordance with the Department's Placement Policy.

Friendship Fire Think Sheet for Home

In the Banyule Bulletin last week, we shared how parents can differentiate between a 'Friendship Fire' and 'Mean-on-Purpose' behaviour. This week, we share how you can help your children step back from their emotions & consider the conflict from a more objective perspective.

We have provided an activity below to complete with your child to support this at home.

Remember, there are many more resources available for free in the <u>'Parent Portal'</u> on the URSTORNG website.

Objective

Reflection sheets and journaling are great ways to help our children process those tricky emotions and express their feelings on paper. But, sometimes kids need to step out of their emotional cloud when they experience conflicts in their friendships to see things clearly.

<u>Dr Susan David</u>, *author of Emotional Agility*, describes the importance of widening the lens to see things from a broader perspective. This Friendship Fire Think Sheet is designed to help children gain a more objective perspective of the situation, looking beyond their heightened emotions to simply focus on the facts.



Materials

Print out: Friendship Fire Think Sheet

Instructions

- 1. Explain to your child that you've noticed they're experiencing a Friendship Fire and that you're here to help.
- 2. Give them the Friendship Fire Think Sheet and say, "Here's a little something that schools sometimes give kids to help them think about the situation a little differently. Maybe it will help you feel better?"
- 3. If they're comfortable, review it with them and be sure to encourage them to Talk-it-Out with their friend to get the friendship back in the healthy zone. If they can't find a good time to talk at school, maybe you could help them set up a time outside of school?

Remind your child that you're there to support and coach them along, but that they can do it! Sometimes time and space away from the Friendship Fire are exactly what they need to start feeling better again!

Consider taking Dr Susan David's <u>Emotional Agility Quiz</u>. It might inspire some ideas for how to help your child be more emotional agile too!





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
