


## COLOUR RUN - CALL FOR DONATIONS

If you are struggling to get your kids to try new veg, try this veggie-loaded snack the kids will love – it's crunchy golden and tastes amazing!

### INGREDIENTS

- 1 head Cauliflower (separated into florets.)
- 1 cup All Purpose Flour
- 1 cup Soda Water (carbonated water, or water)
- 1 tsp Sea Salt (to taste)
- · 2 1/2 cups Bread Crumbs (Panko )
- 1 1/2 tsps Smoked Paprika
- 1 tsp Garlic Powder
- · 1 tsp Black Pepper
- 2 tbsps Extra Virgin Olive Oil (spray or brush on)

#### DIRECTIONS

- 1. Wash and dry the cauliflower head. Cut them into florets. Approximately 3 Cups of florets. Steam for 2 minutes and drain.
- 2. For the flour slurry Add flour, soda water, salt in a mixing bowl and whisk smooth. Flour slurry should be thick enough to coat the florets well and set it aside.
- 3. For Panko seasoning Combine panko, spices in a bowl. Mix with a fork.
- 4. Dip the cauliflower florets individually into the flour slurry, shake off any excess and then into the panko seasoning.
- 5. Preheat the Air fryer at 200C for 3 minutes.
- 6. Working in batches, Arrange the coated cauliflower florets in a single layer into the air fryer basket.
- 7. Air fry for 10 minutes or until browned. At half time, brush the cauliflower generously with oil.
