WHAT IS IT?

WHERE CAN I TAKE MY CONTAINERS?



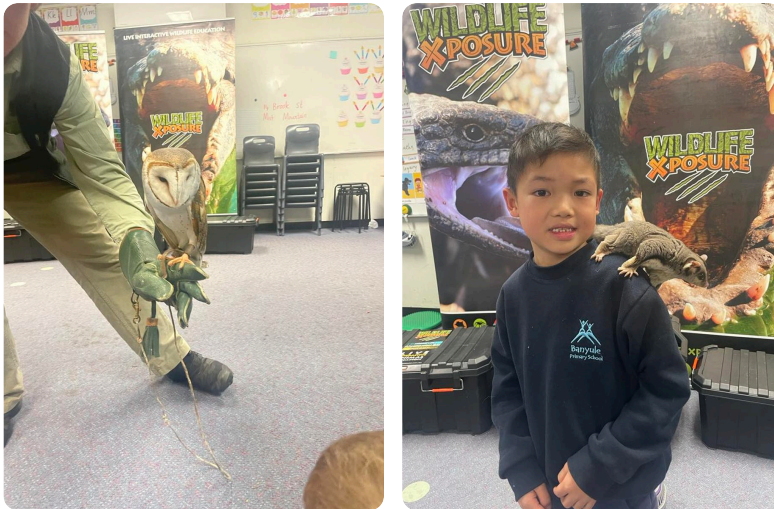




Year 1 Community

A big thank you to the parents helpers who dedicated their own time to help out on the excursion too.

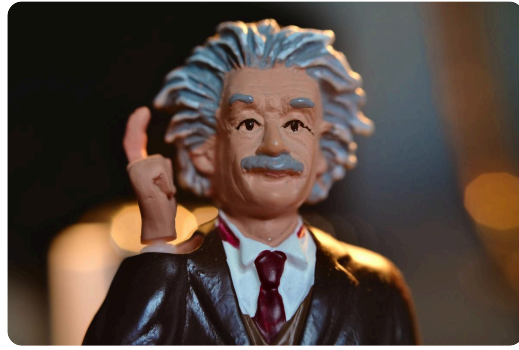


The students have developed a much deeper understanding of the living world around them and this knowledge will culminate with a research poster that they will present to their class at the end of term!

If you are struggling to get your kids to try new veg, try this veggie-loaded snack the kids will love – it's crunchy golden and tastes amazing!

INGREDIENTS

- 1 head Cauliflower (separated into florets.)
- 1 cup All Purpose Flour
- 1 cup Soda Water (carbonated water, or water)
- 1 tsp Sea Salt (to taste)
- 2 1/2 cups Bread Crumbs (Panko)
- 1 1/2 tsps Smoked Paprika
- 1 tsp Garlic Powder
- 1 tsp Black Pepper
- 2 tbsps Extra Virgin Olive Oil (spray or brush on)

DIRECTIONS

1. Wash and dry the cauliflower head. Cut them into florets. Approximately 3 Cups of florets. Steam for 2 minutes and drain.
2. For the flour slurry - Add flour, soda water, salt in a mixing bowl and whisk smooth. Flour slurry should be thick enough to coat the florets well and set it aside.
3. For Panko seasoning - Combine panko, spices in a bowl. Mix with a fork.
4. Dip the cauliflower florets individually into the flour slurry, shake off any excess and then into the panko seasoning.
5. Preheat the Air fryer at 200C for 3 minutes.
6. Working in batches, Arrange the coated cauliflower florets in a single layer into the air fryer basket.
7. Air fry for 10 minutes or until browned. At half time, brush the cauliflower generously with oil.
